ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA & SELECTION PROCEDURE OF ADMISSION FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION: 2025-27

- A. Master of Physical Education (M.P.Ed.) (Two Years P.G. Degree Course with 40 seats)**
(Recognized by the Govt. of Odisha & NCTE and affiliated to Fakir Mohan University).
- B. Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.Ed.) (Two Years Degree Course 100 seats)**
(Recognized by the Govt. of Odisha & NCTE and affiliated to Fakir Mohan University).
- C. Certificate in Physical Education (C.P.Ed.) (Two Years Certificate Course 50 seats)**
(Recognized by the Govt. of Odisha & affiliated to Board of secondary Education, Odisha)

A. M.P.Ed.: (TWO YEARS DURATION)

Eligibility Criteria for M.P.Ed. Course

- I. Candidates who have obtained at least 50% marks in the B.P.Ed. Degree/B.Sc. Degree in physical education, health education & sports are eligible for admission.
- II. The reservation in Seats & Relaxation in the qualifying marks for SC/ST/OBC and other categories shall be as per the rules of the Central/State Government of Orissa, whichever is applicable.
- III. The upper age limit of the candidate intending for M.P.Ed. admission is 40 years as on 01/07/2025 and for in service candidate there is no upper age limit.

Selection Procedure for Admission in to M.P.Ed. Course

- I. Total 200 marks are allotted for selection of deserving candidates.
- II. There will be a theory (objective type) test for 100 marks. The duration of examination is 2 hours. The questions for the test shall cover theory syllabus of B.P.Ed. Course.
- III. Other 100 marks shall be given on academic and sports performances of the candidates. Candidates shall be given 1(one) mark for every percentage of mark beyond 50 percentage of marks in the aggregate of qualifying examination. Candidates representing the State/University in any Sports & Games shall be given 30 marks. Candidates securing 1st, 2nd & 3rd positions in State/ University (Inter district/ Inter College) sports and games competitions shall be given 20, 18 & 16 marks respectively. Possession of NCC 'C' certificate/ Diploma in Yoga, Coaching, Sports psychology, Sports management, Sports journalism, Olympic education and like shall fetch 30 marks.
- IV. The 30 highest scores secured by the applicants shall be included in the merit list and shall be invited for admission on merit.
- V. All the candidates appearing the selection test shall undergo a medical check-up by medical personnel as appointed by the institution. Failing to qualify in the medical test the candidates shall be kept out of the admission selection. Candidates must have adequate medical fitness to resist serious physical exertion during training.
- VI. For appearing in the medical examination, an applicant has to pay Rs.100/- in college cash counter on the day of the test as per the intimation sent to the applicant.
- VII. Admission to the course shall be confirmed after verification of original testimonials in respect of eligibility and payment of required fees. Printed college receipts must be obtained from the cash counter for any payment either in cash or draft.

B. B.P.Ed.: (TWO YEARS DURATION)

Eligibility Criteria for B.P.Ed. Course

- I. Bachelor's Degree in any discipline with 50%marks and having at least participation in Inter college/zonal/district/school competition in sports and game as recognized by AIU/ IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.
OR
Bachelor's Degree in physical education (B.P.E.) with 45% marks.
OR
Bachelor's Degree with physical education as a Compulsory / elective subject with 45% marks.
OR
Bachelor's degree with 45% marks and having participated in national/inter university/state competition or secured 1st, 2nd or 3rd position in inter college/ inter zonal/ Dist./School competition in sport and games as recognized by AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt of India.
OR
Bachelor's Degree with participation in international competitions or secured 1st 2nd or 3rd position in National / Inter University Competition in sports and games as recognized by respective federations/ AIU/ IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.
OR
Graduation with 45% marks and at least 3 years teaching experiences (For deputed in-service candidates i.e. trained physical education teachers/coaches only)
- II. The reservation in seats & relaxation in the qualifying marks for SC/ST/OBC and other categories shall be as per the rules of the Central/State Government of Orissa, whichever is applicable. However, 5% relaxation in mark be given to ST/SC/OBC & other Eligible Categories Candidate
- III. **Age Limit for Admission:** * The B.P.Ed. applicants must be within the age group of 20 yrs. to 28 years for General male, 20 yrs. To 33 yrs. For female & SC/ST Candidates and 20 yrs. To 31 yrs. For OBC/SEBC candidates as on 01/07/2025. For in-service candidates maximum age limit extended up to 45 years. Privilege of the admission shall be given to the applicants having less than 25 years of age. Application of in-services candidate must support with NOC from concern BEO/DEO, failing which the application will be rejected.

Selection Procedure for Admission in to B.P.Ed. Course

- I. Total 300 marks are allotted for selection of deserving candidates.
- II. There will be a theory examination of 100 marks.
- III. There will be a fitness & personality test for 100 marks. The test items are Broad Jumps 100 mts run and putting the shot (16lbs.) for men and for women test items are same except the weight of the shot will be of 10lbs. All these 3 tests carry 30 marks each and 10 marks allotted for personality test (viva-voce).
- IV. Other 100 marks shall be given on past academic and sports performances of the candidates as provided by the candidate in the submitted application forms. Candidates shall be given 1(one) mark for every percentage of mark beyond 50 percentage of marks in the aggregate of qualifying examination. Candidates representing the State/ University in any Sports & Games shall be given 30 marks. Candidates securing 1st, 2nd, & 3rd positions in State/ University (Inter district/ Inter College) sports and games competitions shall be given 20, 18 & 16 marks respectively. Possession of NCC 'C' certificate/ Diploma in Yoga, Coaching, Sports psychology, Sports management, Sports journalism, Olympic education of a duration of minimum one year and like shall fetch 30 marks.
- V. Candidates below 25 years of age shall be given 10 bonus marks.
- VI. Candidates with qualification of Postgraduation in any academic discipline or B.Ed. shall be awarded 10 bonus marks.

- VII. The 60 highest scores secured by the applicants shall be invited for admission on the prescribed date.
- VIII. All the candidates appearing the selection test shall undergo a medical check-up by medical personnel as appointed by the institution. Failing to qualify in the medical test the candidates shall be kept out of the admission selection. Candidates must have adequate medical fitness to resist serious physical exertion during training.
- IX. For appearing in the medical examination, an applicant has to pay Rs.100/- in college cash counter on the day of the test as per the intimation letter sent to him/ her.
- X. Admission to the course shall be confirmed after verification of original testimonials in respect of eligibility and payment of required fees. Printed college receipts shall be obtained from the cash counter for any payment either in cash or draft.

C. C.P.Ed. (TWO YEARS DURATION)

Eligibility Criteria for C.P.Ed. Course

- I. Senior Secondary School (+2) or its equivalent examination passed with at least 50% marks.
- II. However, 5% relaxation in mark be given to ST/SC/OBC and other Eligible Categories Candidate or those who has at least participated in International/National/SGFI/ Sports Competition or Position holders in inter-zonal Sports Competition.
- III. The C.P.Ed. applicant must be within the age group of 18 years to 28 years as on 01/07/2025. However, the upper age limit is 30 years in-service Candidates. Application of in-services candidate must support with NOC from concerned BEO/DEO, failing which the application will be rejected.

Selection Procedure for Admission in to C.P.Ed. Course

- I. Total 300 marks are allotted for selection of deserving candidates.
- II. There will be a theory examination of 100 marks.
- III. There will be a fitness & personality test for 100 marks. The test items are Broad Jumps 100 mts run and putting the shot (16lbs.) for men and for women test items are same except the weight of the shot will be of 10lbs. All these 3 tests carry 30 marks each and 10 marks allotted for personality test (viva-voce).
- IV. Other 100 marks shall be given on past academic and sports performances of the candidates as provided by the candidate in the submitted application forms. Candidates shall be given 1(one) mark for every percentage of mark beyond 50 percentage of marks in the aggregate of qualifying examination.
